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MELBOURNE CUP - OFFICE CLOSURE

Our office is in Melbourne and will be closed on Monday 3rd and Tuesday 4th November.

TZV UNIFORMS CASE

The case is set for hearing this Thursday. We will be arguing that NBN cannot change the Control Room Protocols to remove the provision that allows the wearing of casual clothes on weekends. We argue that this forms part of the EBA and cannot be changed by management action. This has been a long running dispute and several mediations failed to resolve the matter.

TZV TRANSLATION DISPUTE

This dispute involves the Ops EBA and the translation of staff from the old structure to the new structure. It involves recognition of part years when translating. 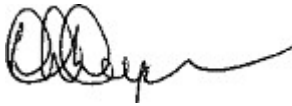
TELSTRA HFC REDUNDANCY
